1. The purpose of this announcement is to solicit Industry, Academia, and Government initiatives for the FY-20 Navy Tactical Exploitation of National Capabilities (TENCAP) Project Selection process. The TENCAP process provides a critical avenue for the Navy to rapidly leverage the vast capabilities inherent in our National and Intelligence Community assets. We have canvassed the fleet for their requirements and ideas, and encourage you, our government, academic, and industry partners to provide innovative, high return-on-investment solutions that we can adopt, trial, experiment, and prototype rapidly in order to meet those requirements in line with the Chief of Naval Operations (CNO) design for maintaining maritime superiority.

2. TENCAP initiatives can span any of the Information Warfare pillars: Assured Command and Control (AC2), Battlespace Awareness (BA), and Integrated Fires (IF), with preference for initiatives that focus on the Fleets' highest priorities. Submission guidelines are included in Enclosure (1) and due no later than 31 May 2019. Detailed requirements and potential concepts are available in Enclosure (2) on SIPRNET and JWICS only.

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4. Submissions will be reviewed by Navy TENCAP and fleet stakeholders and a subset chosen for in-person briefing in July 2019. Final selections are expected by August 2019 in advance of FY-20 funding.


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
