Coaches & Mentors: You can advise and help students in Imperial, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino and San Diego County Students.

Two Divisions you can help: Junior Varsity (Grades 6 to 8) and Varsity (Grades 9 to 12)

Wondering about being a Coach or Mentor for the SoCal Cyber Cup?

For teachers, parents and Software / Cyber professionals, helping younger generations to explore and develop an interest in STEM through the Cyber Cup is a powerful way to give to your community.

Who can be a Coach or Mentor? For Coaches, we recommend an adult parent, coach, youth leader or teacher. For Mentors, we encourage members of the SW and Cyber community at large to join us. If appropriate, older siblings with a SW degree, education or work experience in Cyber Security also make excellent Mentors.

How do we sign-up? First, ensure you have a team of 3 to 8 students in either the Junior Varsity or Varsity division. Then, go to EventBrite and Register your team!

How much does it cost? The CyberCup is free to all participants, coaches and mentors.

What dates and time will I need to commit?

- Registration is open until January 31, 2020.
 - You have time to help your students form a team. If you don't have a team, we will pair you as a coach or mentor.
- Coach and Mentor Orientation & Training will be the weeks of February 3 & 10, 2020 for one hour.
 - Online tutorials are available now, on-demand at the NDIA website below now.
- Practice Rounds will be held Feb 15 to March 1, 2020.
 - Each team signs-up for a 4-hour slot for the Practice Round. Set aside 6 hours including set-up & debrief.
- Qualification Round will be March 12 to March 17, 2020.
 - Each team signs-up for a 2-hour slot for the Qualification Round. Set aside 4 hours including set-up & debrief.
- Finals will be held live at University of California, San Diego on May 9, 2020.
 - Teams usually drive the morning of competition, and home that evening.
