Join Us and Win Grants for your Team! Registration is now open for the 11th Annual SoCal Cyber Cup Challenge! In the last ten years, teams have been awarded over \$140,000 in Grants from the Challenge to further Cyber Security education for their team(s).

Who can Play? Open to Middle and High Schoolers in the counties of Imperial, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino and San Diego, the Cyber Cup provides hands on experience and learning with Cyber Security. Compete against students from 115 other school districts, Boys/Girls Clubs, Churches and other Cyber Clubs!

Forming a Team is Easy. Talk to your friends to form a team of **3 to 8** students. Then ask your parent, teacher or another adult to help as your coach.

Wondering how you will learn “CyberSecurity?” If you wish, we will help find a mentor for your team that can guide you through the exciting training steps and learning process.

It's Free for You and Your Team! The CyberCup is free to all participants, coaches and mentors. All you need to do is form the team and have your coach register your team at Eventbrite. Once your coach registers your team, they can forward / send an email to each team member to have them enter their registration information and link-up to your team.

When is it?!

- Registration is open until January 31, 2020.
- Coach and Mentor Orientation & Training will be the weeks of February 3 & 10, 2020.
- Practice Rounds will be held Feb 15 to March 1, 2020.
- Qualification Round will be March 12 to March 17, 2020.
- Finals will be held live at University of California, San Diego on May 9, 2020.
