



Defense Supply Chain Cyber Resilience Labs

Offered in partnership with California's ETP*

This 25-hour readiness workshop is designed to help DoD suppliers understand the DFARS 7012 requirements and forthcoming Cybersecurity Model Certification (CMMC) audit requirements. CMMC is the Department of Defense's (DoD) newest verification mechanism designed to ensure all DoD suppliers employ appropriate cybersecurity controls to adequately protect DoD assets.

The workshop sessions are led by industry experts who will facilitate group learning. Participants who attend the workshop will be expected to complete assigned learning modules to begin developing a Systems Security Plan (SSP) and progress towards becoming compliant with DoD-mandated NIST cybersecurity controls. The classes will be instructor led via a Zoom classroom.

Fee \$795*

*California Businesses may qualify for an ETP subsidized price of \$295. An application is required to be submitted and approved by ETP to receive an offset credit of \$500.

ETP is a CA Agency that provides funding for training. Eligibility requirements include:

Business is located in CA and pays into the state's Unemployment Insurance tax system; The course participant must complete the training; The business pays participant's wages while in training. Find out more about ETP and fill out an application:
