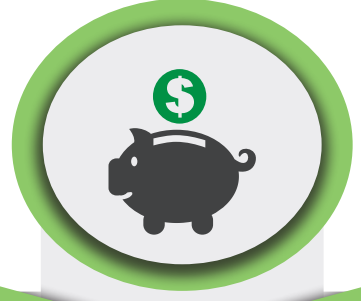
WHO CAN COACH?

An adult parent, coach, youth leader or teacher from a school or youth organization. Coaches are responsible for team management, enforce competition and organization rules, register students. Coach will meet virtually with their team and coordinate training with the mentor, if assigned.



TEAMS

First, form a team of 3 to 8 students in either the Junior Varsity, Varsity or Community College division.
