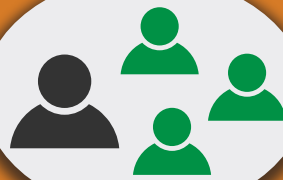

### WHO CAN BE A MENTOR?

Any adult who wants to help students can be a mentor. Go here: <https://tinyurl.com/socal-mentor> to register as a mentor. The first 100 approved mentors will receive a \$250 stipend upon completion of mentor responsibilities. There will be 20 hours of training material available to all mentors. All rounds will be virtual.



## MENTORING

There are two types of mentors:

**Team Mentor** - Work with a specific team and help them prepare for competition.

**Skill - Skill mentors** will provide training to all participants in a specific topic area, ie networking. (These slots are limited).



## COMMITMENT

Team mentors are expected to meet virtually with their team once a week or as needed. Mentor completes at least 20 hours of provided cybersecurity training sessions and will provide / assign training to their team on core cybersecurity and competition topics. Training starts January 1, 2021. Mentor registration is open until March 15, 2021.

### KEY DATES

Registration is open through April 15, 2022.

- ◆ February 15 to May 16, 2021 - Practice gym open
- ◆ 9 am April 21 to 9 pm April 23, 2022 - Qualifier window (teams sign up for 6 hour window)
- ◆ May 21, 2022 - Finals round will be held virtually, top 8 teams from each division.
