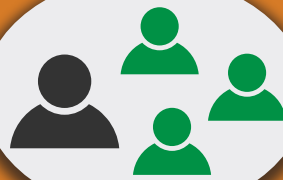

WHO CAN BE A MENTOR?

Cybersecurity subject matter experts and those with cybersecurity knowledge who want to help students can be a mentor. Go here: <https://tinyurl.com/socal-mentor> to register as a mentor. There will be 20 hours of training material available to all mentors. All rounds will be virtual.



MENTORING

There are two types of mentors:

Team Mentor - Work with a specific team and help them prepare for competition.

Skill - Skill mentors will provide training to all participants in a specific topic area, ie networking. (These slots are limited).



COMMITMENT

Team mentors are expected to meet virtually with their team once a week or as needed. Mentor completes at least 20 hours of provided cybersecurity training sessions and will provide / assign training to their team on core cybersecurity and competition topics. Training starts February 6, 2023 Mentor registration is open until March 15, 2023.

KEY DATES
