The SoCal Cyber Cup is a middle school, high school and community college cyber competition. As a Coach, you can advise and help students in Imperial, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino and San Diego counties. All competition rounds will be virtual.



## Who can coach?

An adult parent, coach, youth leader or teacher from a school or youth organization. Coaches are responsible for team management, enforce competition and organization rules, register students. Coach will meet virtually with their team and coordinate training with the mentor, if assigned.
