Commitment

Team mentors are expected to meet virtually with their team once a week or as needed. Mentor completes at least 20 hours of provided cybersecurity training sessions and will provide / assign training to their team on core cybersecurity and competition topics. **Training starts March 6, 2024 Mentor registration is open until March 15, 2024.**



Mentoring

There are two types of mentors:

Team Mentor - Work with a specific team and help them prepare for competition.

Skill Mentor - Provide training to all participants in a specific topic area, ie networking. (These slots are limited).

Practice gym: Feb 6 - May 11, 2024

Qualifier Round: May 2 @ 9 am - May 4 @ 9 pm, 2024 (teams sign up for 6 hour window)

Finals Round: May 11, 2024 will be held virtually for the top 8 teams from each division.
