## Who can compete?

Students in middle school, high school and community college in the counties of Imperial, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino and San Diego. The Cyber Cup provides hands-on experience and learning with Cybersecurity. Compete against students from 115 other school districts, Community Colleges, Boys/Girls Clubs, Churches and other Cyber Clubs!



## COMPETITION DATES

**Registration:** Feb 6 - April 15, 2024.

**Practice gym:** Feb 6 - May 11, 2024

**Qualifier Round:** May 2 @ 9 am - May 4 @ 9 pm, 2024 (teams sign up for 6 hour window)

**Finals Round:** May 11, 2024 will be held virtually for the top 8 teams from each division.



## It's free!

The Cyber Cup is free to all participants, coaches and mentors. Form a team and have your coach register it. Once your coach registers your team, they will forward you an access code to register and self organize onto a team unless the Coach submits a team roster.



## Teams

Forming a team is easy! Talk to your friends and students in STEM clubs / classes to form a team of 3 to 8 students. Ask a parent, teacher or another adult to help as your coach. Need to learn "Cybersecurity?" We can help find a mentor for your team!
