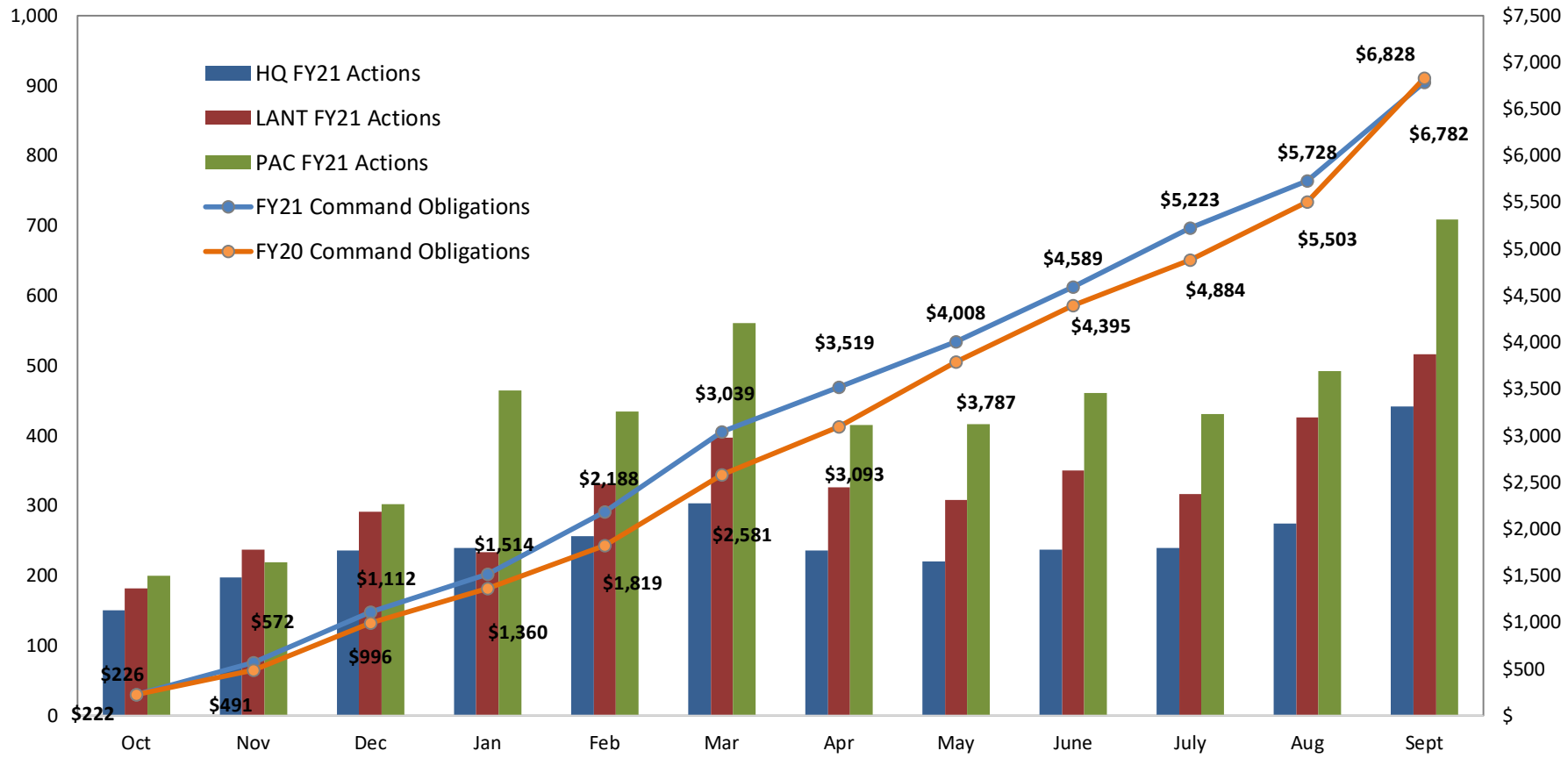

Cumulative Contract Obligations (\$M) and Monthly Contract Actions by Activity

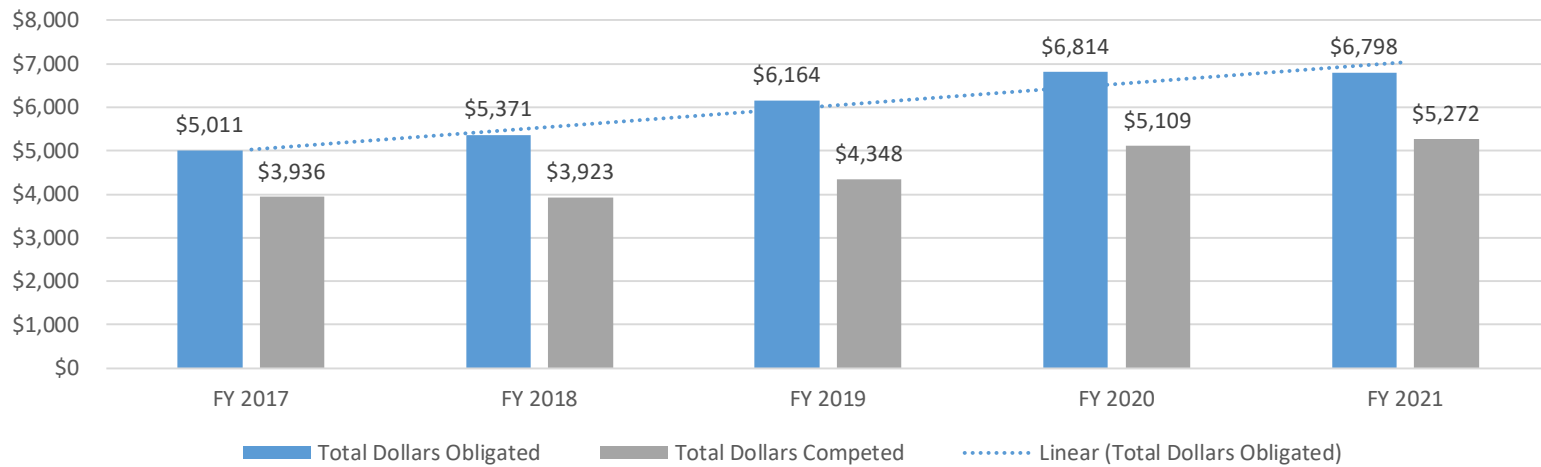

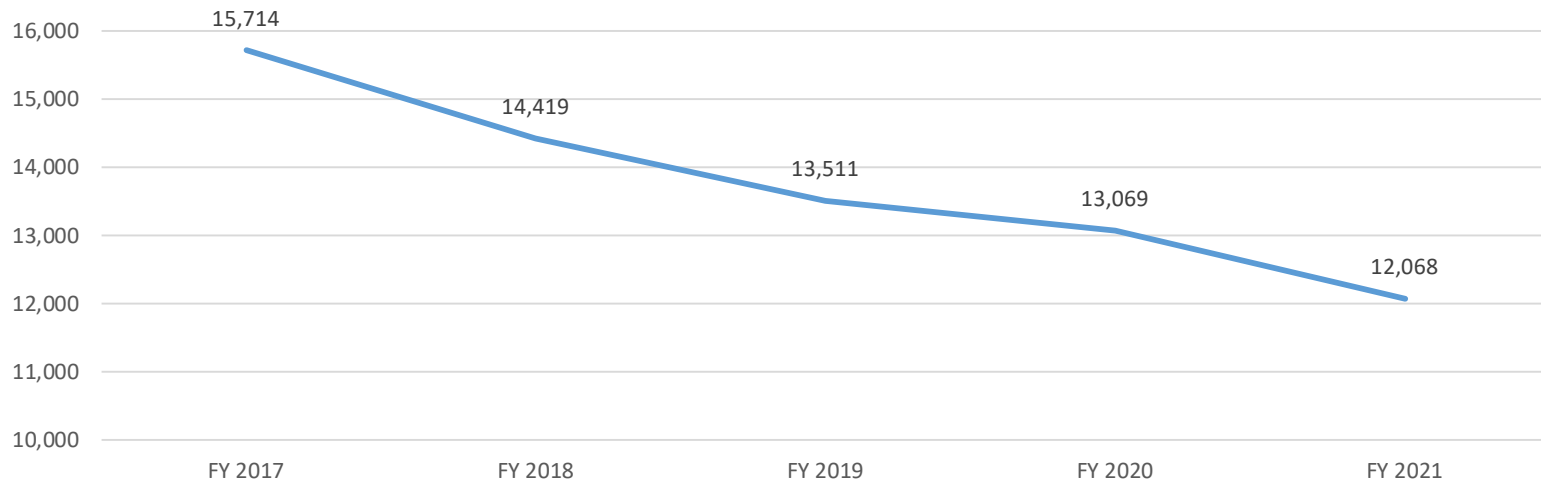


Year to Year Trends – FY17 to FY21

Total and Competed Dollars

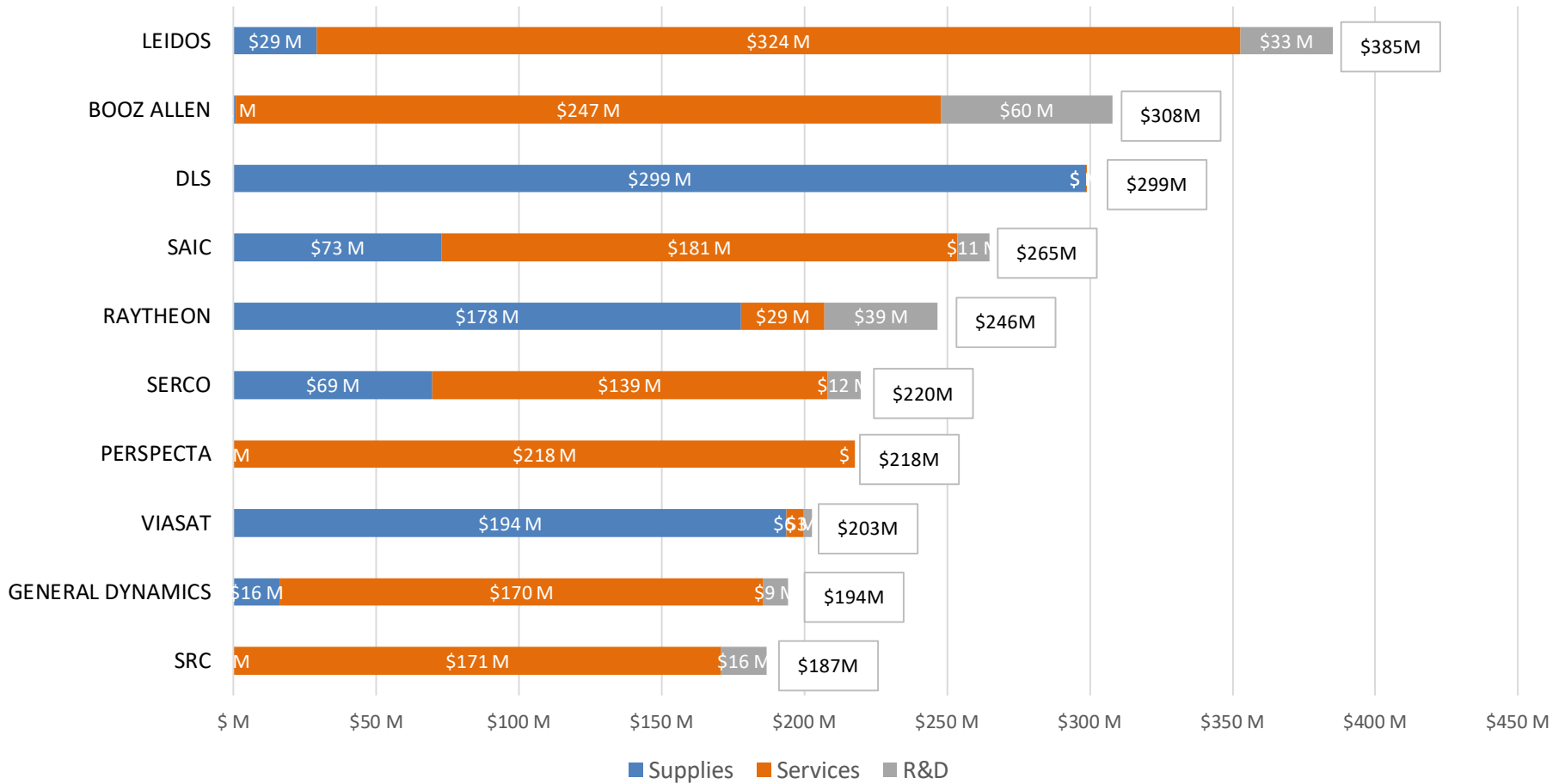

FY21 Top Ten Contractors

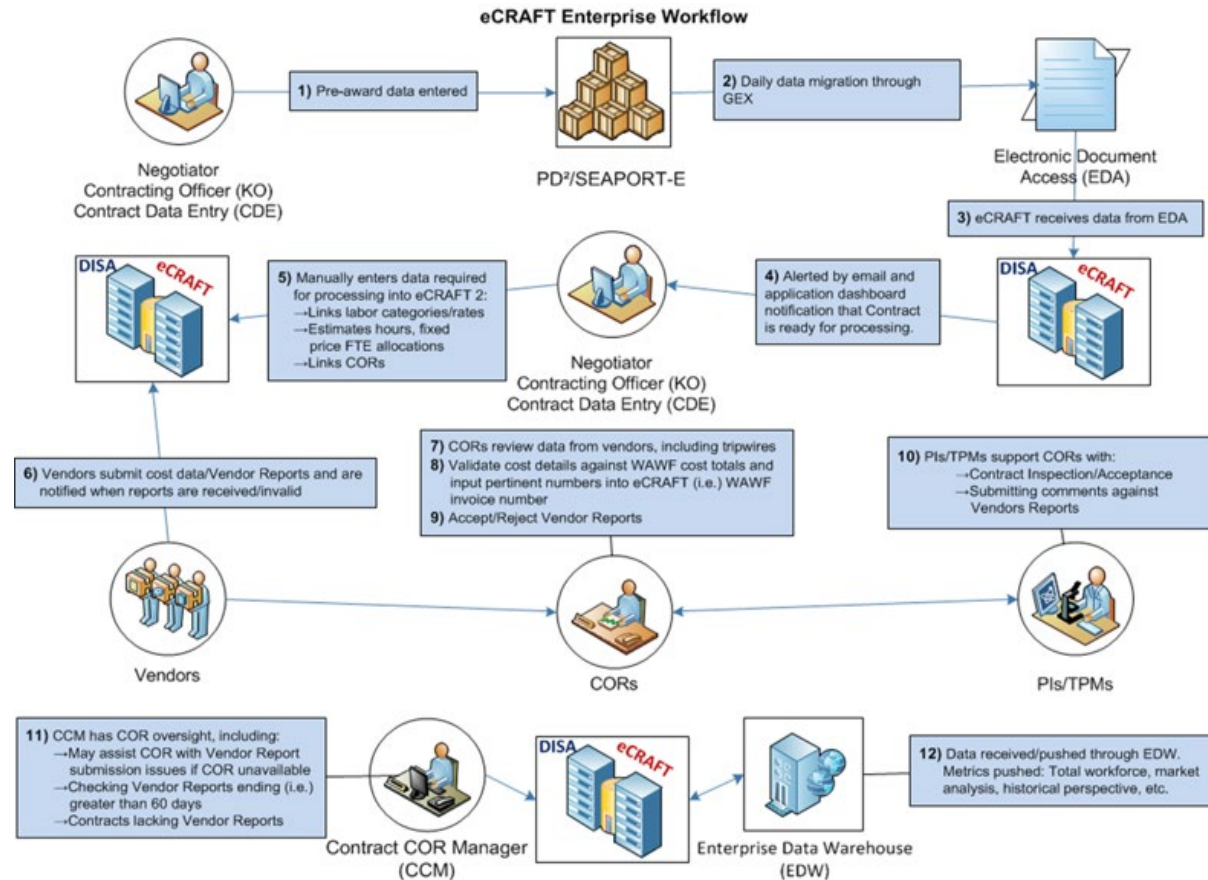




FY22 Service Contract Initiative – eCRAFT

electronic Cost Reporting and Financial Tracking

- ▼ **Secure online system** designed and used by the NAVSEA Warfare Centers
- ▼ **Post-award** tool that tracks and supports monitoring of cost-type service contract cost data
- ▼ **Centralized database** to contain all service contract cost data
- ▼ **Built-in requirement** for service contract vendors to submit detailed cost reporting data into eCRAFT each time they submit an invoice to WAWF





FY22 Acquisition Management Initiative – AMS

Acquisition Management System

- ▼ **Integrated business suite** to plan and execute procurements – from requirements identification through contract award and administration – and includes performance metrics/visuals to streamline and simplify reporting

AMS is a holistic application that manages all phases of the Acquisition Procurement Process

NAVWAR Early Adopters Implemented: PMT and CDRL Modules

Procurement Management Tool (PMT)

Follows a procurement from need identification through contract closeout. The system formalizes the requirements development and approval process and allows a user to track and report progress and other procurement details as it moves through the process flow.

Contract Data Requirement List (CDRL)

Workflow tool that covers the entire CDRL process from drafting DD1423's to acceptance and review of deliverable documents, followed by a formal disposition process, if required. The CDRL tool acts as a searchable database for deliverable documents which have been uploaded to the tool.

Common Spend Plan Tool (CSPT)

Provides an integrated way for developing spend plans, identifying potential issues, and monitoring program budget execution regardless of appropriations or funding sources.
