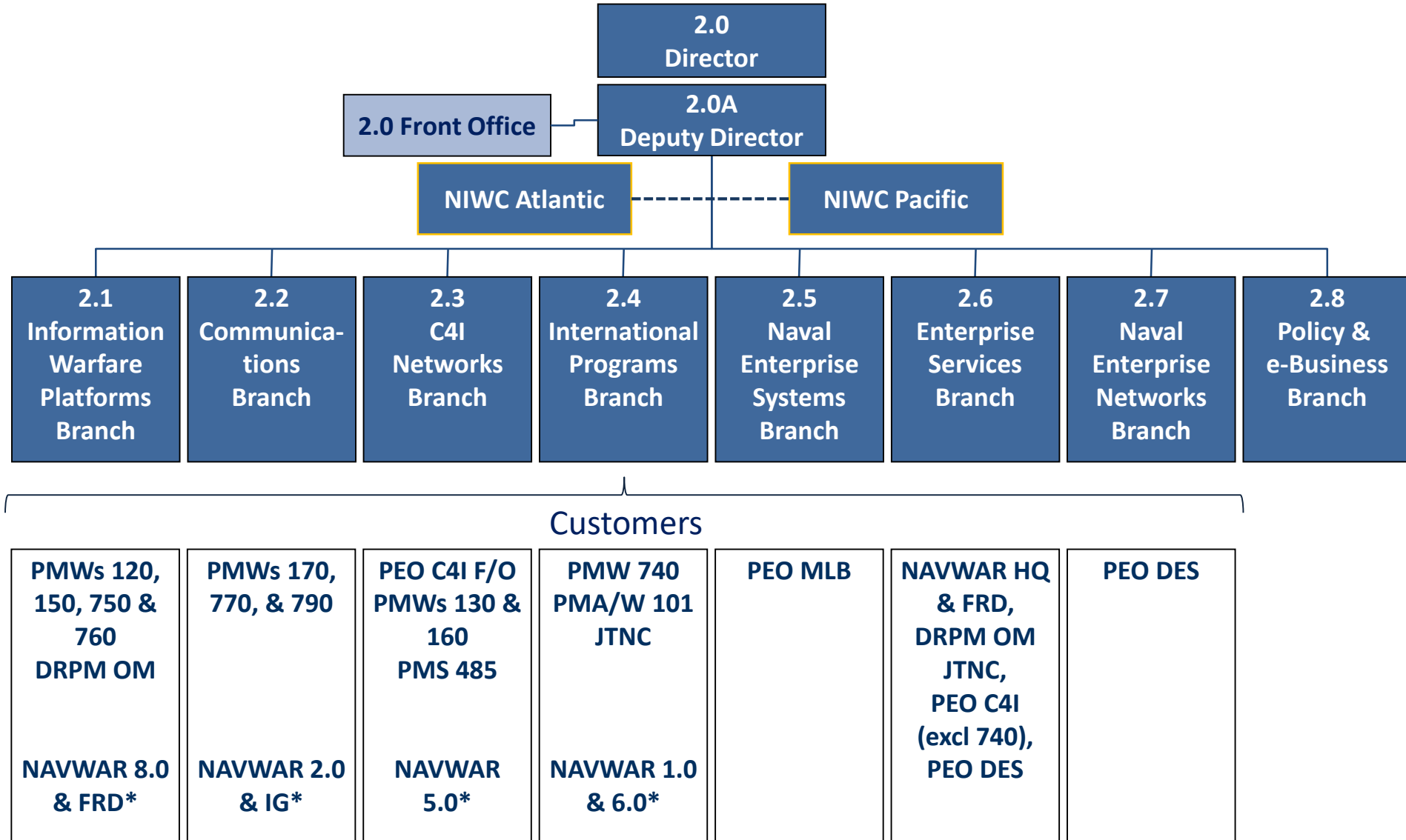

NAVWAR 2.0 HQ Organization



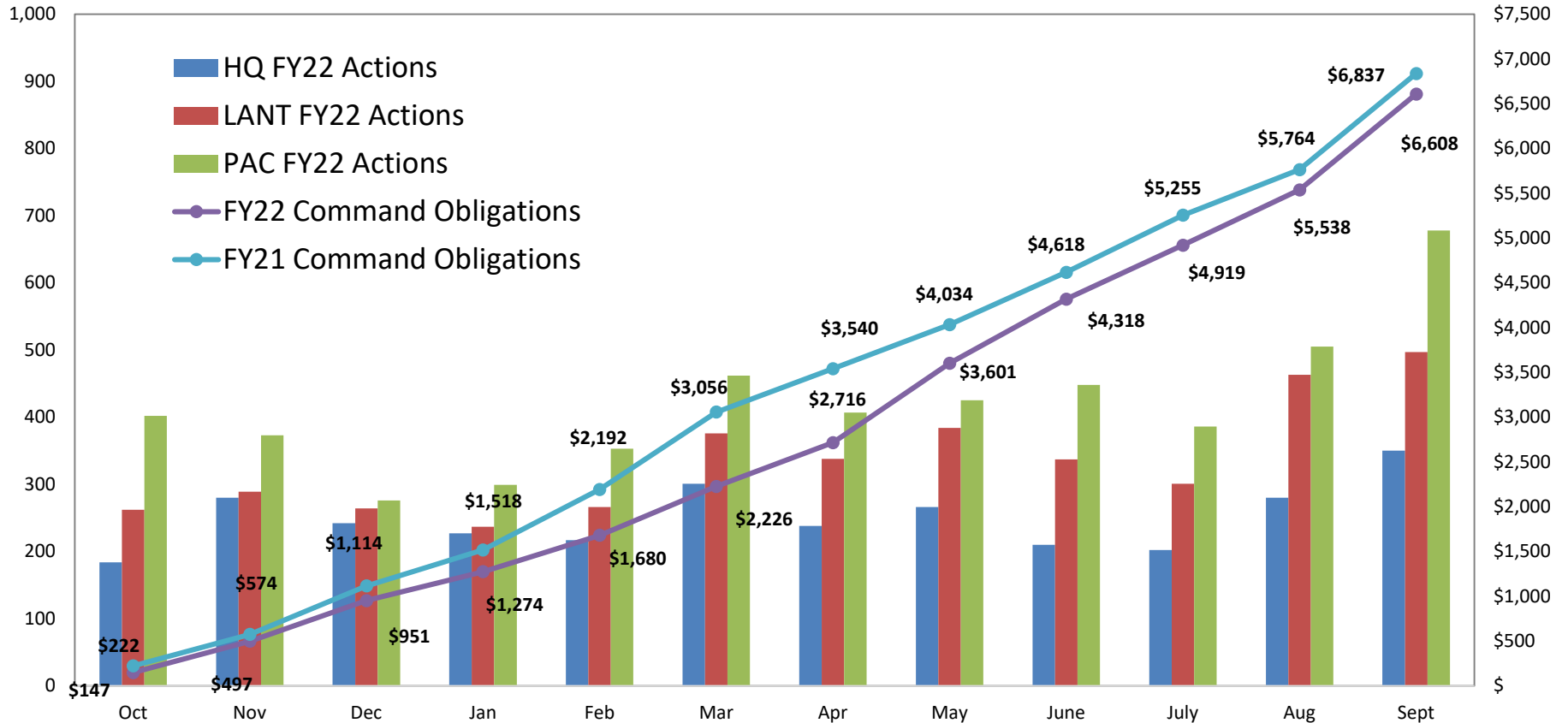

Cumulative Contract Obligations (\$m) and Monthly Contract Actions by Activity



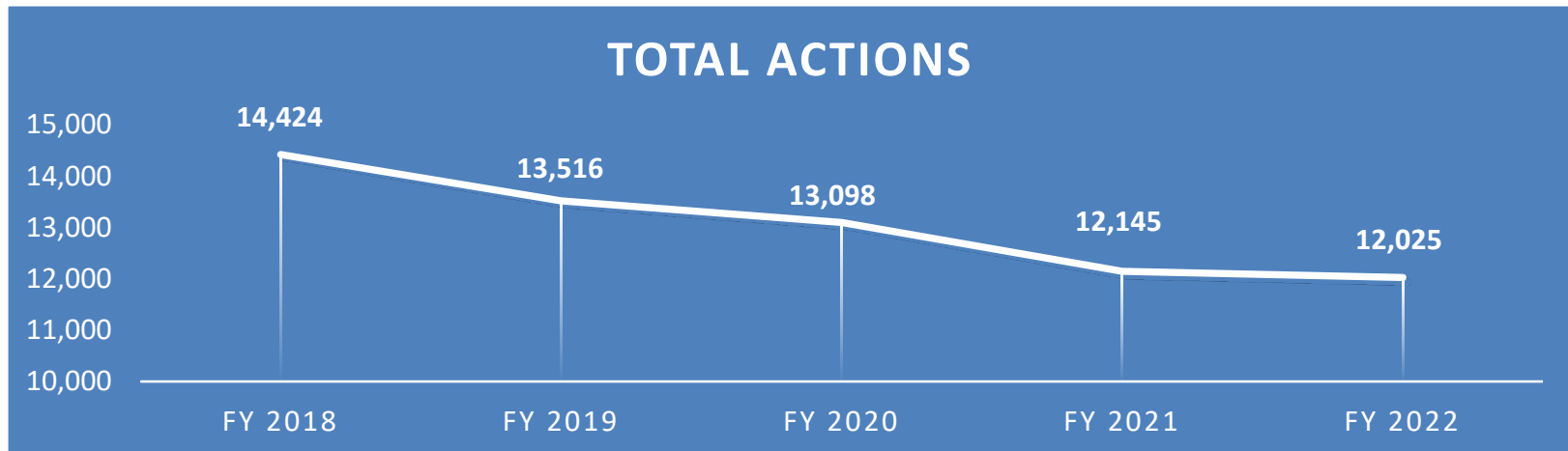
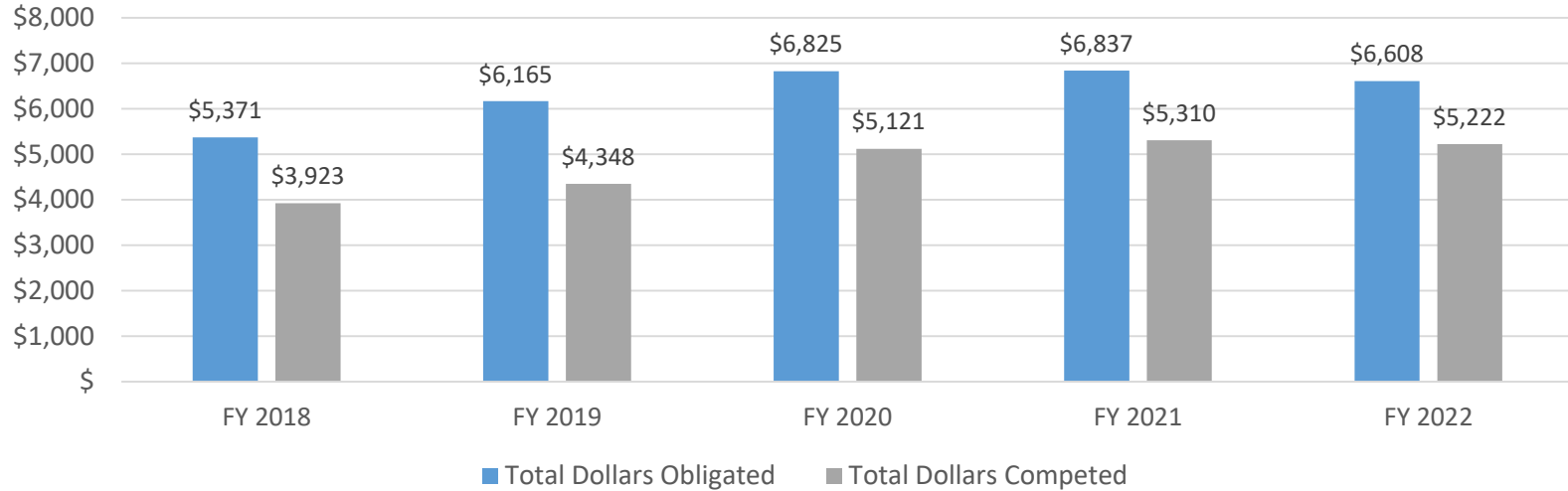

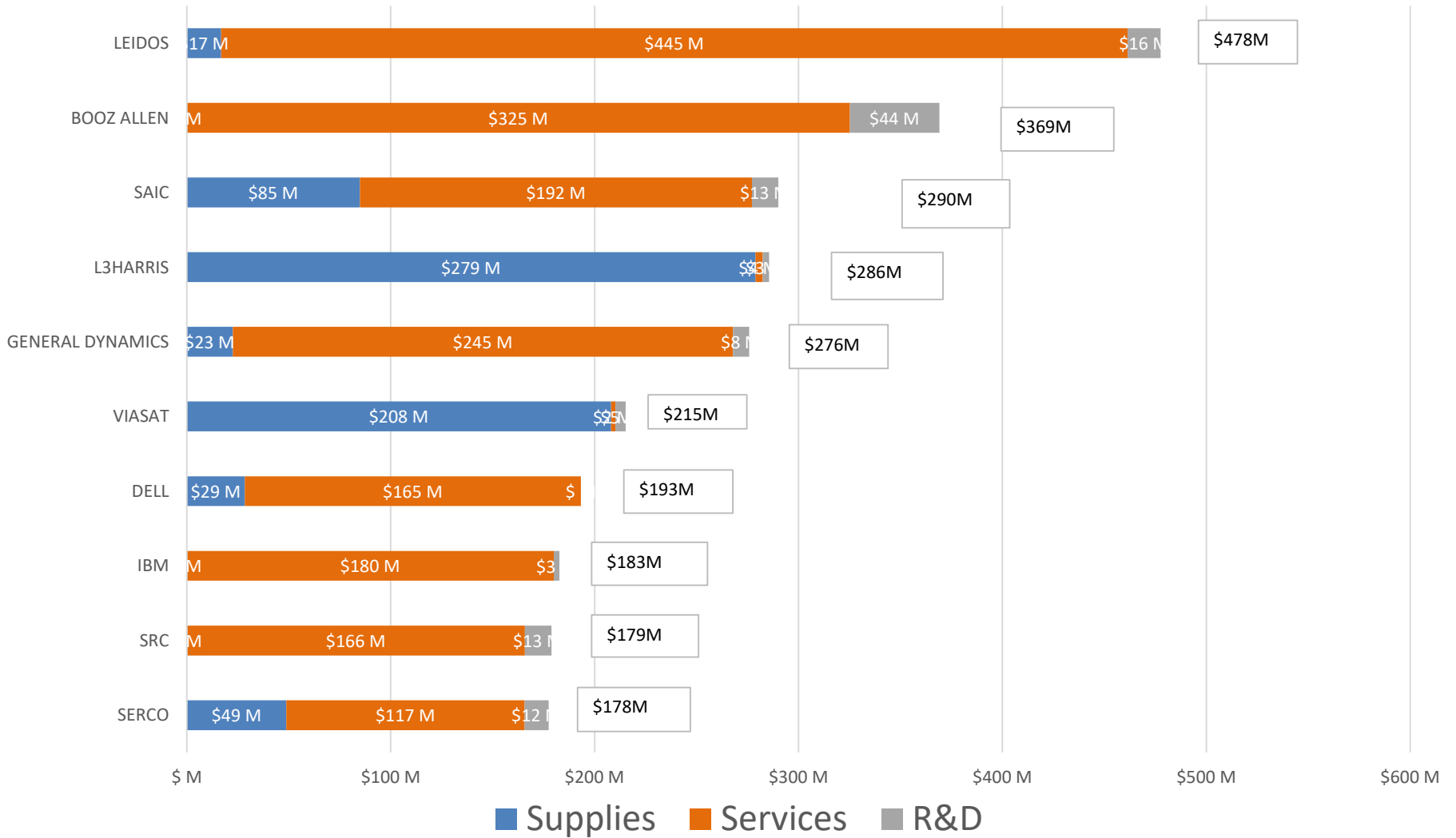
Total and Competed Dollars (\$m)

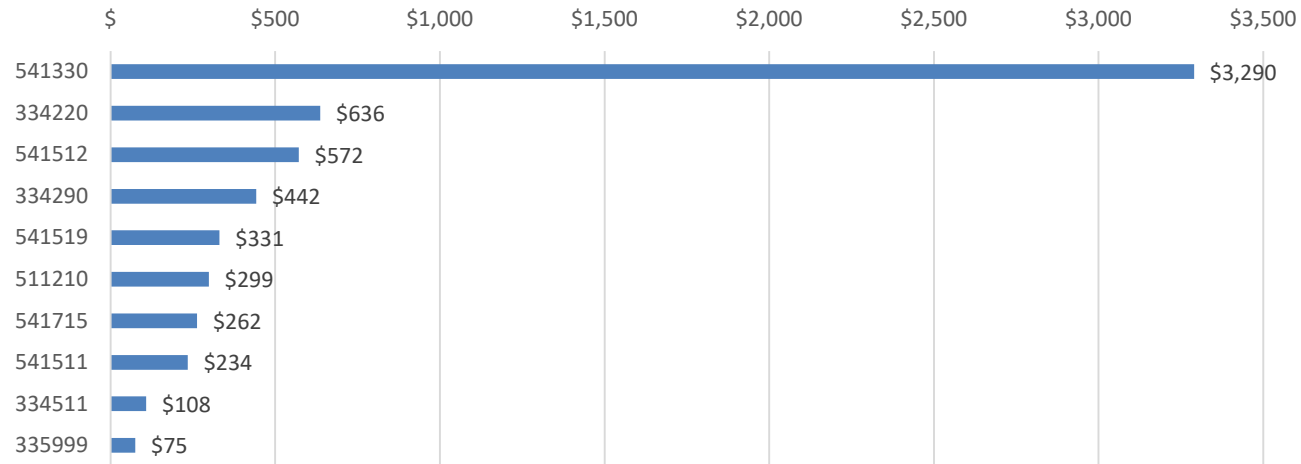

FY22 Top Ten NAICS and PSCs

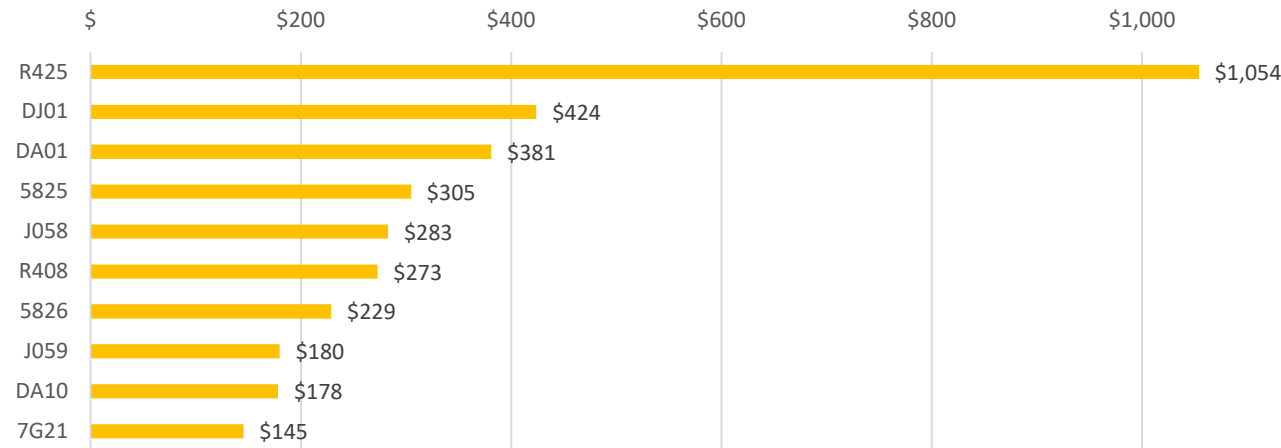
