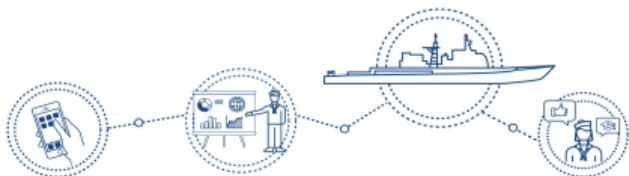

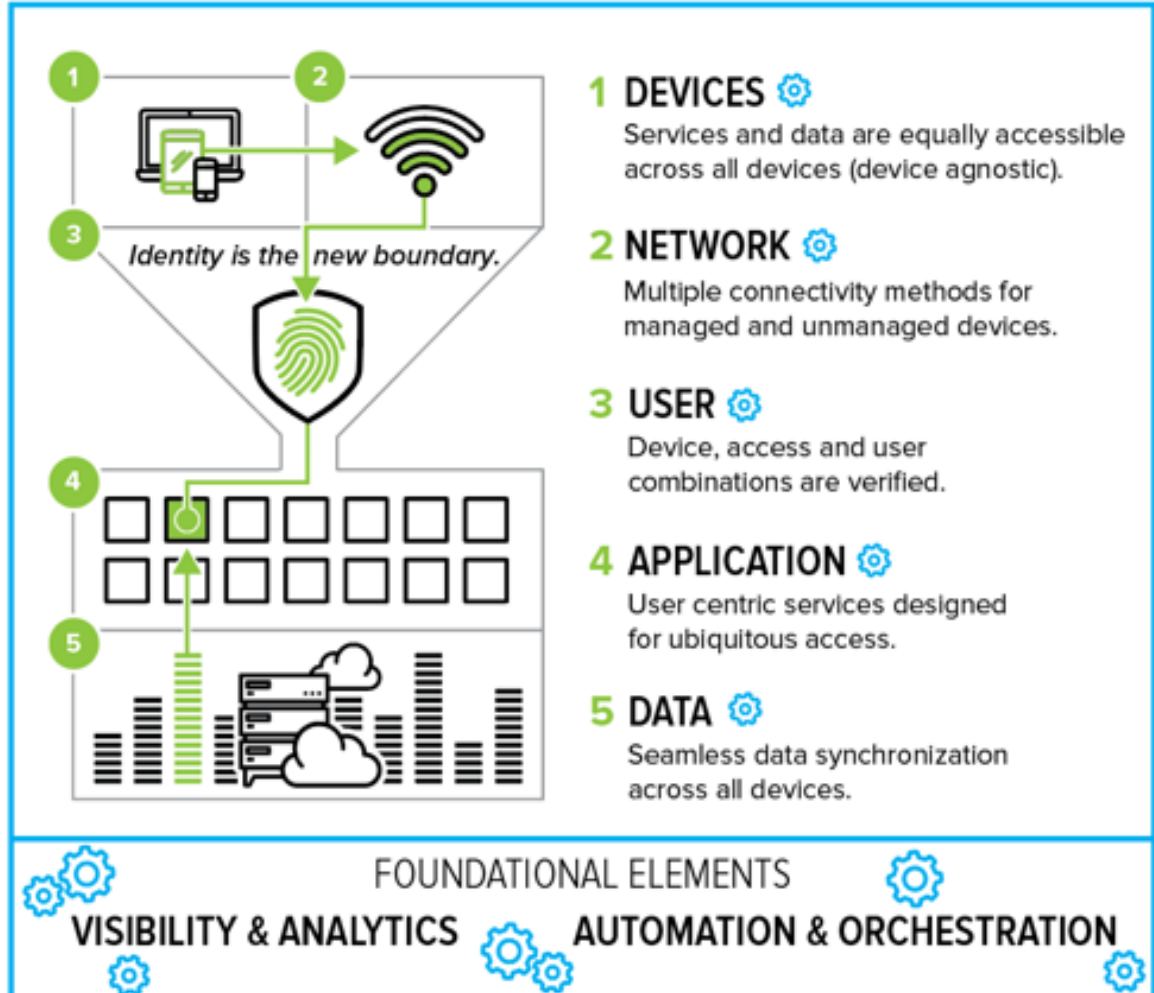

Access to the services and data is seamless to the user at home, at work and on the go.



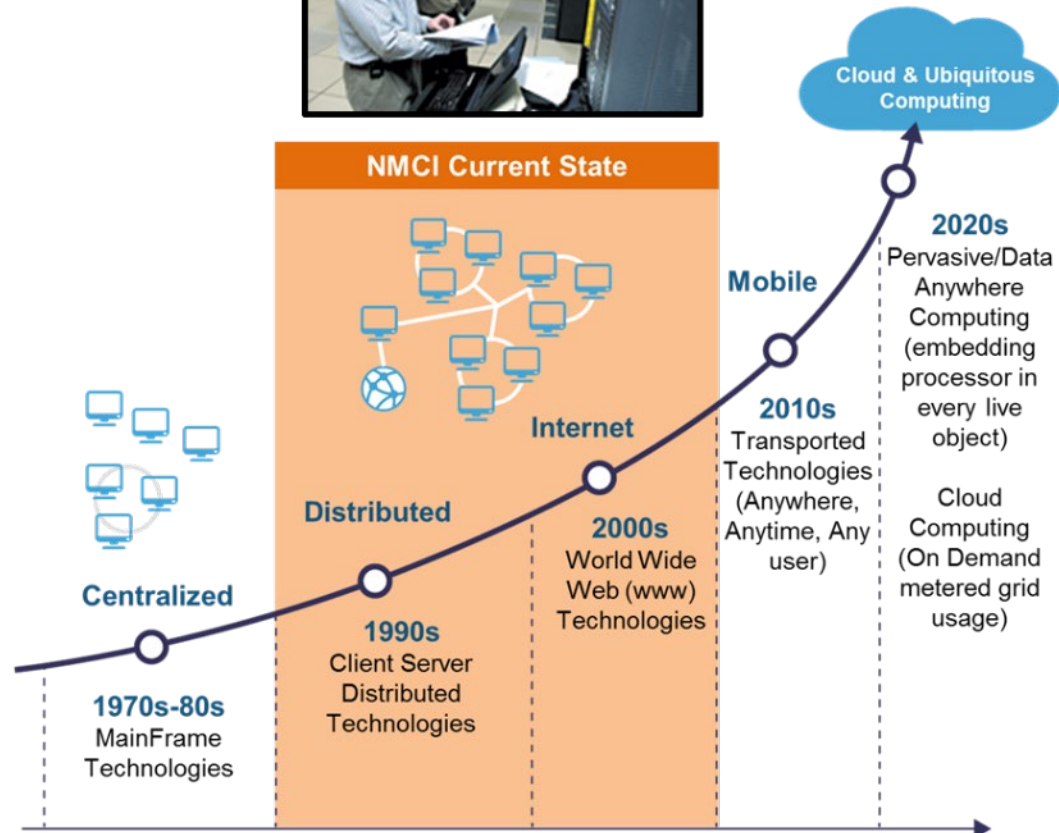


Navy Network requirements support an Intranet designed to meet the needs of a static, localized workforce executing defined, linear processes
